Words that are nonsense or have no meaning

# GOBBLEDYGOOK

*Example:*

He was using too many technical words so everything sounded like gobbledygook.

*Definition:*

Harsh, unpleasant loud sounds

# CACOPHONY

*Example:*

The sounds of barking dogs and sirens added to the cacophony on the streets.

*Definition:*

a commotion or fuss, especially one  
caused by conflicting views:

# KERFUFFLE

*Example:*

There was a kerfuffle over who won the game.

*Definition:*

Existing or being everywhere at the same time:  
constantly encountered: widespread

# UBIQUITOUS

*Example:*

Cell phones are now ubiquitous and people are no longer impressed when they see one.

*Definition:*

To perplex (someone) greatly; bewilder; confuse.

# FLUMMOX

*Example:*

He was flummoxed by the question.
